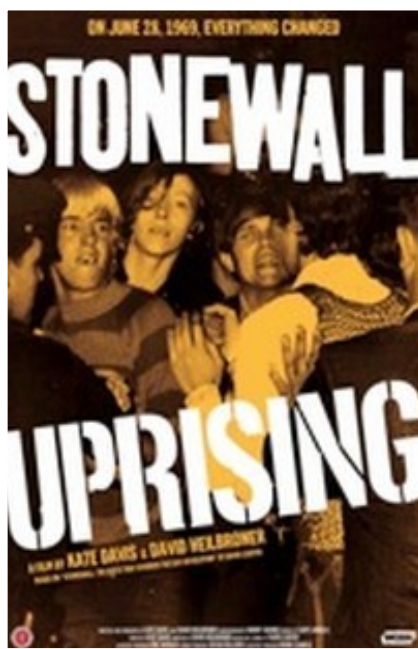


Where were you on June 28, 1969?



"It was the Rosa Parks moment," says one man. June 28, 1969: NYC police raid a Greenwich Village Mafia-run gay bar, The Stonewall Inn. For the first time, patrons refuse to be led into paddy wagons, setting off a 3-day riot that launches the Gay Rights Movement.

Told by Stonewall patrons, Village Voice reporters and the cop who led the raid, STONEWALL UPRISING compellingly recalls the bad old days when psychoanalysts equated homosexuality with mental illness and advised aversion therapy, and even lobotomies; public service announcements warned youngsters against predatory homosexuals; and police entrapment was rampant. A treasure-trove of archival footage gives life to this all-too-recent reality, a time when Mike Wallace announced on a 1966 CBS Reports: "The average homosexual, if there be such, is promiscuous. He is not interested in, nor capable

of, a lasting relationship like that of a heterosexual marriage." At the height of this oppression, the cops raid Stonewall, triggering nights of pandemonium with tear gas, billy clubs and a small army of tactical police. The rest is history."

Pam accomplished owning and operating two night clubs, one in Fairhaven and Le Place in New Bedford, for over 36 years. She was a ray of sunshine and an inspiration to all she met. Most would describe her as the most generous, caring, kind soul with an amazing sense of humor.

The South Coast LGBTQ Network held several events at Le Place over the past five years, including Pride After Parties. Le Place is the only gay bar in the South Coast and its longevity is thanks to the perseverance of the owners. Pam and her partner, Lucy Langevin, always went out of their way to make their establishment available to the Network and the Imperial Court of Rhode Island for fundraisers and social events, and were most hospitable hosts.

Pam had a charisma about her that made everyone want to be her friend. She will be missed. Rest in peace, friend.

Remembering Belle A. Pellegrino



Belle A. Pellegrino, 74 of Providence, entered into eternal rest on December 10, 2018 after an illness. She was born in Providence a daughter of the late Thomas and Florence (King) Pellegrino.

Belle served in the United States Marine Corps in 1968 and 1969 when she was Honorably discharged in September. She volunteered for The Colonie Fire/Police Dept. as an EMT. She was a Chaplain for the TriCounty Vets., a Pastor at UFMCC of Albany, she was also a dispatcher at the Warwick Fire Dept..

Belle was one of the original 76ers and also worked to ensure that the first Gay Pride Parade occurred. She was Emperor 16 and 24 at the Imperial Court of Rhode Island (ICRI). She was well known to the LGBTQ community in the Greater New Bedford and Fall River areas, lending her support for events and fundraisers at Le Place, New Bedford and other venues throughout the South Coast. Belle attended New Bedford's first Pride hosted by South Coast Equality in 2008.

Belle Pellegrino was well known and will be remembered for her kindness, love and acceptance of all those she touched.

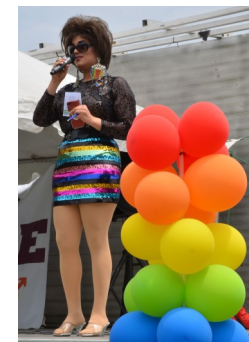

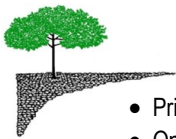
